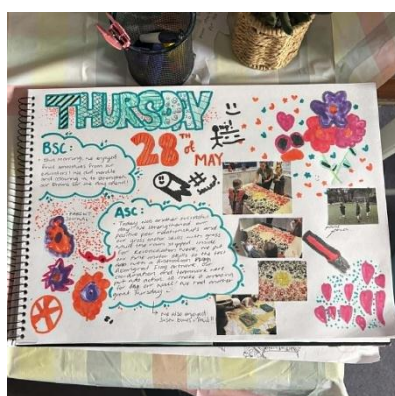

PROGRAM

During Week 6, children participated in a range of engaging experiences that supported creativity, problem-solving, collaboration, physical development and self-expression. Indoor activities such as creating Captain America shields, the LEGO boat challenge, Newtonian fluid experiments, literature club and sunset drawing encouraged imagination, critical thinking, STEM learning and fine motor skill development. Outdoor experiences including soccer, AFL, stop motion activities, soccer practice, sliding doors, base building and a soccer match promoted teamwork, communication, resilience, coordination and gross motor skills. Children also enjoyed dancing club, one bounce, handball, musical chairs, basketball and cooking brownies, which provided opportunities to build confidence, social connections and healthy lifestyle habits. As part of Reconciliation Week, children engaged in a hand-painting art experience where they created the Aboriginal Flag. This activity supported cultural awareness, respect and understanding of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, encouraging meaningful conversations about Australia's history, identity and the importance of reconciliation. Children's Choice sessions throughout the week further promoted agency, decision-making, independence and a sense of belonging within the service.
